

Search Macros Box

Run **Search Macros**, then...

Search for "Copy"

Search for "Paste"

Search for "Sheet"

Search for "Cell"

Search Commands Box

Run **Search Commands**, then...

Search for "Copy"

Search for "Paste"

Search for "Sheet"

Search for "Cell"

Picker Macros

Run **Highlight Color Picker** macro

Enter option 1

Enter option 2

Change default value to 4

Change default value back to 1

Enter custom value for option 3

Change custom value for option 3 back

X 16738047-Pink DEFA

X 255-Red DEFAULT3

Toggle Macros

Run **Toggle Cell Highlight** (**Ctrl+y** shortcut)

Run 6 times to cycle through all colors

Run for multiple ranges to show uses top-left cell as basis

Settings Sheet Macros

Run **Save Sheets To PDF** macro

Copy data from SSTP sheet into that sheet and run again

Show the files saved out in the File Explorer window

Assigning Keyboard Shortcuts

Run **Assign Macro Shortcuts** macro

Show data validation lists to assign keys

Set **Ctrl+h** for Find Replace Picker macro

Show print preview for coverage/printout

Run again to process

Use **Ctrl+h** shortcut to show shortcuts were set

Run **Macro Shortcut Picker** (**Alt-2** shortcut)

Point out the macro assigned to **Ctrl+h** and enter "h" and run

Run **Search Macros** macro and search for **Find Replace Picker**

Note that shortcut appears

Unset that shortcut

Try **Ctrl+h** again to show that re-instates standard Find/Replace dialog box

Setting Default Values

Run [Assign Macro Defaults](#) macro

Change setting for Highlight Color Picker option 3

16738047-Pink

Run again to process

After processing, test [Toggle Cell Highlight](#) to show default was updated

Run Highlight Color Picker macro to change option 3 back

X 255-Red DEFAULT3

Setting Custom Macros

Run [Edit Custom Macro File](#) macro to show what custom file looks like

Run again to re-enable

Run [Insert Happy Face](#) to show an example of a custom macro being used
